Our day trip campers will be attending Camp Wooten for the day on Thursday, April 27<sup>th</sup>. Students will participate in camp scheduled classes and activities with the other campers. Students will be taking a bus to Camp Wooten on the morning of April 27<sup>th</sup> and returning by bus later that evening.

We will be loading the bus at Prosser Heights Elementary School's front parking lot starting at 7:00 am on April 27<sup>th</sup>. The bus will be leaving Prosser Heights Elementary School at 7:15 am. The weather can be very unpredictable at Camp Wooten. **Students are required to arrive with a hat, gloves, shoes (preferably boots) and a winter coat. Students may choose to bring a backpack to store these items in during the day.** Students will not be allowed to board the bus without these items.

The bus will leave Camp Wooten after dinner at 6:45 pm on that same day. The bus will arrive in Prosser around 9:45 pm. Parents will need to pick-up their child in town at Prosser Heights Elementary School's front parking lot.

## WHAT-TO-TAKE CHECKLIST
